The Jeju Foundation for Arts and Culture(JFAC), and the Jeju Special Self-Governing Province are accepting applications for the 「2021 JEJU-UCLG Global Young Creatives Residency “Islands in Flow”」. UCLG Global Youth Creatives Residency is in its third year, and we bring young artists and young creative individuals from Korea and abroad to this beautiful islands of Jeju. Participants will be teamed up with domestic and international mentors to have an intense creative experience. We welcome creative young people to this residency where there will be creative flow, exchange of inspirations, and engagement with the local and global themes in this island with magnificent natural beauty and stories of thousands of gods and goddesses.

1. Overview

- **Title** : 2021 JEJU-UCLG Global Young Creatives Residency (GYCR)
- **2021 Subject** : Islands in Flow
- **Hosted by** : The Jeju Special Self-Governing Province / The Jeju Foundation for Arts and Culture
- **Supported by** : UCLG, JDC
- **Format** : After taking online preparatory lectures and workshops(mandatory), Participants will be put into small groups of creative individuals with mentors in the areas of visual art, architecture, history, literature, and theater. Each team will be housed in a remote village in the main Jeju island and islets around Jeju, where they will co-create a project.
- **Number of participants** : Domestic 12 / International 12
- **Preliminary information session (online)** : 28 May 14:00 (JFAC youtube channel)
- **Orientation** : 7 July
- **Preparatory lectures and workshops (online)** : 12 July ~ 23 July
- **Intensive residency program (on the islands)** : 2 August ~ 6 August
(* The dates are subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen factors.)

2. Benefits

- Participation is free (We provide airfare, meals and accommodation)
 - ① Airfare : Domestic flight cost up to 200,000 won will be reimbursed after the residency.
Please submit the boarding pass and receipt for your flight to JFAC. (Please arrive before 10 am, Aug 2 for the beginning of the residency. The detailed schedule will be provided later)
 - ② Accommodation : Shared accommodation is provided for 4 nights (Aug 2 ~ Aug 6). No single room is available.
 - ③ Meal : Meals are provided but we may not be able to accommodate specific dietary needs since restaurant options are very limited in local villages. Please contact us with food concerns and prepare to cook your food if necessary.

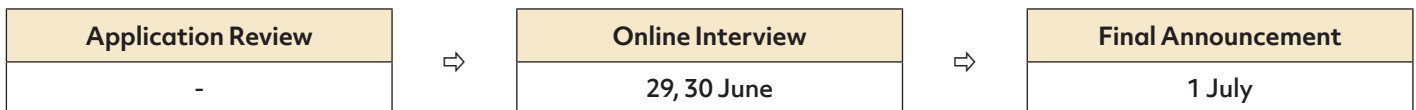
3. Participants

- **Qualification** : Young creative individuals regardless of major or genre who are either from Jeju (or affiliated with Jeju through education or career) or from overseas (* due to COVID-19, we are accepting foreign applicants this year who are already residing in Korea only)
- **Age** : Born between 2 January 1981 ~ 1 January 2002

4. Selection Process



- ① Application Deadline : 24 June 18:00
 - ② After reviewing applications, short-listed applicants will be contacted individually to arrange online interviews.
 - ③ Online interview will be conducted by zoom.
 - ④ Selected applicants will be contacted individually on 1 July.
- (*The date of final announcement is subject to change)

5. Notice

- If submitted documents are false or fabricated, selection will be canceled and the person will not be able to participate in the future.
- If selected applicants cancel participation after the final announcement is made due to personal circumstances, the participant is not allowed to participate in the next year.
